ROBEN ANDERSON ANNOUNCES RUN FOR WEST FARGO CITY COMMISSION

Roben Anderson is seeking one of two seats up for election on the West Fargo City Commission in June.

West Fargo, ND – On November 5th, 2021 Roben Anderson announced he is running for West Fargo City Commission.

“I’m running to give the residents someone on the commission that will listen to them and appreciate their input,” Roben said. “Having a resident first mentality is my number one initiative. The Commission and City Government need to be willing to always listen and gather input from residents. Great ideas come from those who participate.”

Roben has been on the Special Assessment Commission for the last three years and worked on a bill to improve communication and transparency within the Special Assessment process that was signed into law and went into effect earlier this year.

I know it’s cliché, but we need to approach the budget like we do our personal finances. I am willing to make cuts where necessary to make sure we don’t see the continuation of rising property taxes, or a lapse in core functions.”

“I want to make West Fargo a better place to live for future generations. I’m willing to roll up my sleeves and get the work done to address key issues. My hope in June, is that I will have the honor of being elected to the West Fargo City Commission.”
